

Emergency Bursary Application

Please note that emergency bursaries are only available to full-time graduate students. Students must also be registered in the current term to be eligible for the bursary.

Students must complete the bursary application, and submit their application in person at 230 YL or via email at fqssao@yorku.ca.

The intent of emergency bursary program is to assist registered, full-time graduate students who encounter an unexpected emergency. This bursary is not intended to cover tuition fees owing to York and should not be due to lack of planning. Bursaries are not considered to be a source of routine or long-term funding. Bursaries range from \$250 to a maximum of \$1500.

Eligibility:

- Full-time graduate student
- Registered in the current academic session

Awarding of Bursaries:

In assessing bursaries, it is assumed that all efforts have been made by the student to keep costs at a minimum e.g. sharing accommodation, moving to a less expensive apartment, and reducing personal expenses. Decisions on bursaries are not appealable.

Application Information

Please note the following information is required for the application:

- 1. Completed Emergency Bursary application form;
- 2. Letter outlining circumstances (maximum of 2 pages) Letter should address the nature of the emergency. When did the emergency occur? (Approx. month & year), How is the emergency directly and/or indirectly impacting the student's financial situation? What attempts have been made to reduce expenses or secure other funding?
- 3. Documentation should be provided to support the circumstances outlined in the letter.
